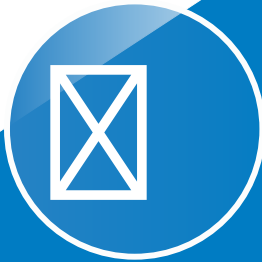




» UNIVERSITY OF RWANDA PUBLIC HEALTH STUDENT ASSOCIATION

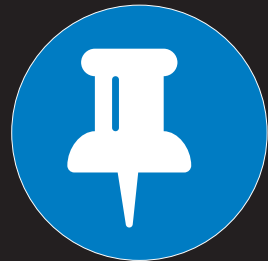


» MISSION
